Area of learning	What we will be learning	
<p>Communication, Language and Literacy</p>	<p>This week, we will be looking at 'Little Red' by Bethan Woollvin. <p>Mathematical Development</p>	<p>We will be carefully counting and representing numbers to 10. We are learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Say one less - Count back - Compare groups by matching 	
<p>Art</p>	<p>Our focus artist is Henri Rousseau. We are learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Explore an artist 	
<p>RE</p>	<p>We will be learning about the Christian creation story. Our BIG question is, 'Why should people look after the world?' We are learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Respond to the Creation story 	
<p>Science</p>	<p>We will be learning about seasonal change and types of trees. We are learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Begin to explore, identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees 	
<p>Jigsaw PSED</p>	<p>This term we will be learning about 'Being Me'. We are learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Recognise the choices I make and understand the consequences - Recognise the range of feelings when I face certain consequences 	
<p>Physical Development</p>	<p>Jenny and Abi will lead Friday PE sessions and class teachers will lead sessions on Monday. We will be learning playground games and practising ball skills this term. We are learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Improve hand eye co ordination - Develop control over a ball 	
<p>Any Other Information</p>	<p><u>PE</u> PE days are Monday and Friday. Please send your child to school in school uniform, as we will be changing at school.</p> <p><u>Library</u> We will be visiting our school library on alternate weeks at school. We are not taking books out of the library until later in the term.</p>

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	<p>We will be sending one phonics book home with each child every week. Please can you keep this in your child's book bag and it will be swapped when they have been read with three times at school.</p>
