<p><b>Mathematical Development</b></p>	<p>We will be exploring addition and subtraction (within 10).</p> <p>We are learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- To write number sentences</li> <li>- Know about fact families</li> <li>- Find number bonds within 10</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Jigsaw PSED</b></p>	<p>We will be celebrating difference in our Jigsaw lessons this term.</p> <p>We are learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Identify similarities between people in my class</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Music</b></p>	<p>We will be exploring timbre and rhythmic patterns through the theme of fairy tales this term.</p> <p>We are learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Select suitable instrumental sounds to represent a character</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Geography</b></p>	<p>This term, we will be following Princess Sue on her adventures, taking a look at the four countries within the United Kingdom.</p> <p>We are learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Talk about England's capital city, London</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Physical Development</b></p>	<p>Jenny and Abi will lead Friday PE sessions and class teachers will lead sessions on Monday. We will be learning multi skills and gymnastics (floor work) this term.</p>	
<p><b>Any Other Information</b></p>	<p><u>PE</u> PE days are <b>Monday</b> and <b>Friday</b>. Please send your child to school in school uniform, as we will be changing at school.</p> <p><u>Library</u> We will be visiting our school library on alternate weeks at school. We are not taking books out of the library until later in the term.</p> <p><u>Reading books</u> We will be sending one phonics book home with each child every week. Please can you keep this in your child's book bag and it will be swapped when they have been read with <b>three times</b> at school.</p>
