| Area of learning | What we will be learning |

| Communication, Language and Literacy | <p>In Phonics, we are recapping the sounds we have learnt this term.</p> <p>In English, we will be continuing our learning based around the book "Man on the Moon". We will be writing our own stories based on the Man on the Moon book and Bob's adventures in space.</p> <p>Spellings of the week are: improve, sure, sugar, eye, could</p> |
| Mathematical Development | <p>In maths, we will be moving onto problem solving and reasoning challenges that use our knowledge on addition and subtraction.</p> |
| Creative Development | <p><u>ART/RHE</u> We will be expressing our individuality through design by using simple shapes to create/draw a pattern on a pair of 'Odd Socks'.</p> <p><u>Music</u> We will be using our voices creatively and expressively to sing songs from our Nativity play.</p> |
| Knowledge and Understanding of the world | <p><u>RE</u> We will be visiting St Cosmas and St Damian's church to ask questions and begin to understand why Christians believe that God gave Jesus to the world.</p> <p><u>History</u> We will be visiting the Garden of Remembrance in Adastral Park to continue our learning about why we have Remembrance Day, the significance of the poppy and other ways that Remembrance Day is commemorated.</p> |
| Personal and Social Development | <p><u>Jigsaw – Anti-Bullying Week.</u> We will be learning about what bullying is and that bullying is sometimes about difference. We will also be thinking about how someone who is bullied feels and discuss how we can be kind to children who are bullied.</p> |
| Physical Development | <p>We will be exploring team games and gymnastics.</p> |
| Any Other Information | <p>Just a reminder, please can you make sure that your child has a pair of wellies in school every day.
