Area of learning	What we will be learning
Communication, Language and Literacy	<p>In Phonics, we will be looking at the alternative spellings for the graphemes /i/ crystal /sh/ ssi, mission, si mansion and /ci/ delicious</p> <p>Our spellings this week are: note, pence, coin, pound, change</p> <p>In English, we will be creating our own poems based on our learning about space.</p>
Mathematical Development	<p>In maths, we will be continuing to explore coins and notes. We will be learning the value of different coins and notes, understanding the £ sign and adding amounts in pounds and pence.</p>
Creative Development	<p><u>ART/DT</u> We will be using our sewing skills to complete our decorations.</p> <p><u>Music</u> We will be using our voices creatively and expressively to sing songs from our Nativity play.</p> <p><u>Light Up Hassocks</u> Some children will be making lanterns for the parade.</p>
Knowledge and Understanding of the world	<p><u>History</u> Big Question: Why did Neil Armstrong go to the moon? This week we will be continuing with our big question and learning about Neil Armstrong's early life.</p> <p><u>RE</u> We will be continuing with our learning about Christianity and finding out about the meaning and traditions of Advent.</p>
Physical Development	<p>We will be exploring invasion games and floor gymnastics.</p>
Any Other Information	<p>We look forward to seeing as many of you as possible on Friday for Light Up Hassocks. Some children will be helping to make lanterns, some children will be holding a lantern in the parade and some children will be performing in the choir.</p> <p>Please can you ensure that all your child's belongings are clearly marked with their name as this makes it much easier to locate and return their property to them when mislaid. The children are welcome to bring in a named extra jumper if they are feeling cold in the classrooms with the windows open.</p> <p>Please can you ensure that your child's costume for the Nativity is in school in a named bag by Friday 2nd December, thank you.
