Area of learning	What we will be learning
Communication, Language and Literacy	We will be introducing our new text, 'Postcards from Crabby Spit' by Roland Harvey. The children will be thinking about what it is like at the beach and using different adjectives to describe seaside experiences. The children will be encouraged to think of their senses to support their descriptions.
	The children will be restarting their Little Wandle phonics sessions in class and on Friday we explore the 'words of the week' spellings; who, why, come, could, would.
Mathematical Development	We will be investigating place value and looking at the different ways we can represent the tens and ones by using a range of manipulatives.
Knowledge and Understanding of the world	RHE Our topic this term is 'Being Me in My World' and this week we will be exploring how our rights and responsibilities help us to learn and keep safe in school.
	Geography We will be looking at the oceans around the world.
Expressive Art and Design	ART
Design	The children will be developing their collaging skills with the focus of creating their own sea animal collage.
Physical Development	We will be exploring team games and practising ball skills.
Any Other Information	The children have had a fantastic first week back and it has been lovely getting to know our new classes.
