

Area of learning	What we will be learning
<p>Communication, Language and Literacy</p> 	<p>In Phonics we will be reviewing sounds taught at the end of Year 1. This week we will be focusing on:</p> <p>/zh/ su treasure si vision /j / dge bridge /i / y crystal /j / ge large</p> <p>We will also be working on our spellings of Year 2 Common Exception Words, specifically: door, floor, poor, because, kind.</p> <p>We will be continuing our learning on our current book 'Flotsman' by David Wiesner. We will be using our skills of observation, questioning and inference and then using our imagination to draw our own picture of an undersea scene which could be in the book. At the end of the week we will be sequencing the events in 'Flotsam'</p>
<p>Mathematical Development</p>	<p>We will be counting forwards and backwards in tens and ones to 100. We will also be estimating where numbers appear on a number line and beginning to talk about more than or less than a given number, understanding how to use the symbols < > and =.</p>
<p>Creative Development</p>	<p>Music We will be learning songs and practising for our Harvest Festival Assembly.</p>
<p>Knowledge and Understanding of the world</p>	<p>Jigsaw – Relationships and Health Education We will be revisiting the concept of the Zones of Regulation to develop the children's range of emotions vocabulary.</p> <p>RE – We will continue to explore Christianity and learning about how Jesus taught people the importance of being kind to each other, through special stories from the bible called parables.</p>
<p>Physical Development</p>	<p>We will be continuing to explore team/playground games and practising dribbling and kicking skills.</p>
<p>Any Other Information</p>	<p>Thank you for sending your child's wellies into school. If your child hasn't brought them in yet, please could they do so. As the weather is turning more Autumnal, please can you ensure that your child comes to school every day with a coat.</p> <p>Our PE days are Tuesday and Thursday. We will be doing PE outside unless it is raining, so please could children wear warm kit when the temperature drops, thank you.</p> <p>We will be posting Words of the Week Spellings on Tapestry every Friday. Please practise these throughout the week with your child.
