| Area of learning | What we will be learning |

| Communication, Language and Literacy |  |
|  | Handwriting: <br> We are using lead ins in all our writing and are focusing on lead ins for harder letters: |
| Mathematical <br> Development | We will be learning about addition this week. <br> We will be: <br> - Learning about fact families. <br> - Understanding that addition can be done by adding the parts in any order to make the whole e.g. $2+3=5$ and $3+2=5$. <br> - Number bonds within 10. For example, $1+7=8$ and $2+6=8$ are bonds to 8 . <br> Maths fluency: <br> We are starting maths fluency sessions. These will be for 15 minutes 4 x a week and will work on building children's understanding of number. <br> This week we will be: <br> - Exploring how 5 can be composed of two parts. Being fluent with number bonds to 5 will support calculations within 10 and beyond <br> Words you might hear your child say! <br> Subitising - when you are able to look at a group of objects and realise how many there are without counting. <br> Part whole - the idea that numbers can be split into parts, which can be used in maths learning <br> Commutative - when 2 numbers can be added or multiplied \& the same answer will be found no matter what order they are in. For example: $3+2=5,2+3=5$; <br> You can ask your child? <br> - Show me a way to make 5. <br> - Show them a number below 5 - How many more to make 5? <br> - What number can you see for different representations. How do you know? |
