Area of learning	What we will be learning
Communication, Language and Literacy	In English we will be reading <i>Man on the Moon by Simon Bartram</i> as we launch our new topic, "To Infinity and Beyond". The children will be developing their inference skills. Inference is all about using what you know so far, to make some predictions. This is a key skill that the children will continue to develop throughout Year 2.
	In Phonics we will be revisiting all the long vowel sounds.
	We will also be working on our spellings of Year 2 Common Exception Words, specifically; father, class, grass, pass, plant
	The children will be learning how to use apostrophes for possession e.g. The man's hat, the cat's basket. They will also be writing questions that they would like to ask Bob from <i>Man on the Moon</i> . This will support the children with using question marks in their writing.
Mathematical Development	We will learning addition and subtraction facts within 100, as well as number bonds within 100. The children will be using a range of manipulatives to support their understanding.
Creative Development	Music We will be focusing on preparing for our nativity this half-term. We will be learning and rehearsing a range of songs from the nativity.
Knowledge and Understanding of the world	History/Art We will be learning about Guy Fawkes and using art to create some fireworks pictures. Computing
	We will be beginning Computing this half-term with a focus on coding. This week the children will use Purple Mash to create a computer program using an algorithm. This will be through an air traffic control game.
	RHE We will be starting our new whole school Jigsaw theme, "Celebrating Difference". We will be thinking about some of the differences between boys and girls and challenging some of the stereotypes that may exist.
Physical Development	We will be exploring Invasion Games and Fitness.
