Area of learning	What we will be learning
<b>Communication, Language and Literacy</b>	<p>In English, we will be continuing our learning based around the book "Man on the Moon". We will be reviewing writing in past tense and sharing exciting adjectives to use in our writing. We will be writing our own stories based on the Man on the Moon book and Bob's adventures in space.</p> <p>In Phonics, we are reviewing:            /or/ - or, a, aw, au, ore, oor, al, oar, our, augh, aur            /zh/ - si, su            /ch/ - ch, tch, ture            /sh/ - sh, ti, ch, ssi, ci, si</p> <p>Spellings this week are: <b>path, bath, hour, move, prove</b></p>
<b>Mathematical Development</b>	<p>In maths, we will be adding by making 10 with lots of practical work and before recording, adding 3 1-digit numbers and adding to the next 10 eg The number is 36. The next ten is 40. <math>36+4=40</math></p>
<b>Creative Development</b>	<p><u><b>ART/RHE</b></u>  <b>We will be expressing our individuality through design by using simple shapes to create/draw a pattern on a pair of 'Odd Socks'.</b></p> <p><u><b>DT</b></u>  <b>We will be designing our own space decoration and planning what materials to use and colours etc. We will also be exploring whip and running stitches and choosing which stitch to use for our decorations.</b></p> <p><u><b>Music</b></u>  <b>We will be using our voices creatively and expressively to sing songs from our Nativity play.</b></p>
<b>Personal and Social Development</b>	<p><u><b>Jigsaw – Anti-Bullying Week.</b></u>  <b>We will be learning about what bullying is and that bullying is sometimes about difference. We will also be thinking about how someone who is bullied feels and discuss how we can be kind to children who are bullied.</b></p>
<b>Physical Development</b>	<p><b>We will be exploring Invasion Games and Fitness.</b></p>
Any Other Information	<p>Please can you make sure that your child has a pair of wellies in school every day. Please can you ensure that your child has the appropriate PE kit in school, including leggings/joggers and a sweatshirt, now that the weather is getting colder. Our PE days are Tuesday and Thursday.
