| Mathematical Development | We are continuing to add by crossing ten and moving on to subtracting by crossing ten. We will be exploring these skills practically, using a variety of manipulatives and developing our use of CPA (Concrete, Pictorial and Abstract). Questions you might ask your child! How many do you start with? How many do you need to take away? What can you partition into? How many do you need to subtract to get 10? How many more do you need to subtract? What is less than? What is the bond to 10 for? What is less than 10? So what is less than? Maths fluency This week, the children will explore the composition of 8. They will recap the position of 8 | |
| Creative Development | in the linear number system. Being secure in relating numbers to other numbers will support the children to develop good number sense, eg: seeing that 8 is between 7 and 9 (and is therefore 1 more than and 1 less than these numbers respectively), as well as relating 8 to the key 'anchors' of 5 and 10. Music We will be using our voices creatively and expressively to sing songs from our Nativity play. | |
| Physical Development | Jenny will lead our Tuesday PE sessions and class teachers will lead sessions on Thursday. We will be learning Invasion Games and Fitness. | |
