

The GPC /s/ c is used at the start or in the middle of words, where c comes before i or y. It can also be used in the middle of a split digraph in words like 'ice'. The spelling pattern ce is used at the end of words, like 'peace' or 'fence'.</p>  </div> </div>
<p>Mathematical Development</p>	<p><u>Time</u> This week we will be learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Tell the time to o'clock and half past the hour Tell the time to a quarter past and a quarter to the hour Tell the time past the hour <p><u>Key Vocabulary</u> Minute hand, hour hand, second hand, minutes, hours, o'clock, half past, quarter to, quarter past,</p> <p><u>Maths fluency</u> This week we continue to focus on subtracting across 10 using the reduction structure.</p>
<p>Knowledge and Understanding of the World</p>	<p><u>Art</u> We will be learning to make texture in clay using a variety of tools.</p> <p><u>Key Vocabulary</u> clay, sculptor, sculpting, texture, technique</p>
<p>Physical Development</p>	<p>Jenny will lead our Tuesday PE sessions and class teachers will lead sessions on Thursday. We will be learning Invasion Games and Tennis.</p>
