

Area of learning	What we will be learning
<p>Communication, Language and Literacy</p>	<div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-between;"> <div style="width: 45%;">  <p>This term's learning is being inspired by the Olympics.</p> <p>This week we will be completing our Kenning poem about our chosen sporting superstar, including all our skills from our Kenning poem toolkit.</p> <p><u>Vocabulary:</u> Kenning poem, noun, stanza, adjective noun pattern, riddle</p> </div> <div style="width: 45%; text-align: center;"> <p><u>Phonics/Spellings</u></p> <p>This week we will focus on: Why do some longer words have the spelling ti for /sh/?</p>  </div> </div>
<p>Mathematical Development</p>	<p><u>Consolidation</u> This week we will be continuing to consolidate all our maths skills. We will be answering arithmetic questions, as well as answering questions related to shape, money, length and height, measure, fractions, time, statistics and position and direction.</p> <p><u>Maths fluency</u> This week's sessions will continue to give the children opportunities to practise solving all types of subtraction calculations, working within 20, using the methods we have previously explored. The problems will be given in the form of part-part-whole diagrams with missing parts.</p>
<p>Personal, Social and Emotional Development</p>	<p><u>JIGSAW – Changing Me</u> This week our Jigsaw learning will be focusing on answering the following questions:</p> <p>Can you recognise how your body has changed since you were a baby and where you are on the continuum from young to old? <u>Key Vocabulary</u> growing up, old, young, change, respect, appearance, physical</p> <p>Can you recognise the physical differences between boys and girls and use the correct names for parts of the body? <u>Key Vocabulary</u> male, female, penis, testicles, vulva, vagina, anus, public, private</p> <p>Can you identify what you are looking forward to when you move to your next class? <u>Key Vocabulary</u> change, looking forward, excited, nervous, anxious, happy</p>
<p>Creative Development</p>	<p><u>Music</u> We will be using our voices expressively and creatively to practise our songs for the 'Leavers' Assembly'.</p>
<p>Physical Development</p>	<p>Jenny will lead our Tuesday PE sessions and class teachers will lead sessions on Thursday. We will be learning Striking and Fielding skills, as well as exploring a variety of Athletics skills.</p>

Any Other Information	<p>General reminders</p> <p>Please can you ensure that your child has the appropriate PE kit in school. Our PE days are Tuesday and Thursday.
