

Area of learning	What we will be learning	
<p><b>Communication, Language and Literacy</b></p>	 <p>This term's learning is being inspired by the Olympics.</p> <p>This week's learning will be learning to write instructions. We will be focusing on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Can I use bossy verbs?</li> <li>• Can I identify a toolkit for writing instructions?</li> <li>• Can I use adverbs to add detail?</li> <li>• Can I add detail to my instructions using conjunctions and adjectives?</li> </ul> <p><b>Vocabulary:</b> imperative verb, bossy verb, instructions, adverb, conjunction, adjective</p>	<p><b>Weekly Spellings</b></p> <p>This week's spellings are: even everybody parents Mr Mrs</p> <p>We will have a spelling quiz on Friday.</p> <p><b>Phonics/Spellings</b></p> <p>This week we will focus on: <b>How do you use the possessive apostrophe?</b></p> 
<p><b>Mathematical Development</b></p>	<p>In Maths this week, we are beginning our 'statistics' topic. The children use and draw their own tally charts, tables, pictograms and block diagrams to represent and find out information.</p> <p><b>Maths fluency</b></p> <p>This week's sessions will continue to give the children opportunities to practise solving all types of subtraction calculations, working within 20, using the methods we have previously explored. The problems will be given in the form of part-part-whole diagrams with missing parts.</p>	
<p><b>Creative Development</b></p>	<p><b>Music</b></p> <p>We will be using our voices expressively and creatively to practise our songs for the 'Leavers' Assembly'.</p>	
<p><b>Physical Development</b></p>	<p>Jenny will lead our Tuesday PE sessions and class teachers will lead sessions on Thursday. We will be learning Striking and Fielding skills, as well as exploring a variety of Athletics skills.</p>	
<p>Any Other Information</p>	<p><b>General reminders</b></p> <p>Please can you ensure that your child has the appropriate PE kit in school. Our PE days are Tuesday and Thursday. Please can long hair be tied back on PE days, as this is a necessary part of keeping the children safe during their PE lessons.</p> <p><b>Year 2 Sports Day</b></p> <p>We look forward to seeing as many of you as possible on Wednesday for our Year 2 Sports Day at Windmills School. We will send the children's PE kits home on Tuesday, so that they can come to school on Wednesday in their kits (coloured T-shirts for their class teams is optional as per previous letter).</p> <p><b>General</b></p> <p>Please can you ensure that all your child's belongings are clearly marked with their name as this makes it much easier to locate and return their property to them when mislaid.</p>
