

Area of learning	What we will be learning	
<p>Communication, Language and Literacy</p>	 <p>We will continue to complete our 'Super Duper Me' booklets this week focusing on presentation, punctuation, exciting words choices and using the features of non-fiction writing.</p> <p><u>Vocabulary:</u> subheadings, facts, fiction, non-fiction, unique, different, personality, hobbies, family, friends.</p>	<p><u>Weekly Spellings</u> This week's spellings are the days of the week: January February March April May</p> <p>We will have a spelling quiz on Friday.</p> <p><u>Phonics/Spellings</u></p> <p>This week we will continue to revisit the following question:</p> <p>When do I swap, double or drop letters before adding a suffix? (-er, -est, -ed, -ing, -y)</p> 
<p>Mathematical Development</p>	<p><u>Maths</u> We will be engaging in a variety of activities this week to consolidate all our year 2 learning and doing lots of 'fun maths'.</p> <p><u>Maths fluency</u> This week's sessions provide an opportunity for the children to use the language of comparison, as well as to read and interpret more complex equations and inequalities. They will use their understanding of commutativity to identify that equations such as $4 + 6 = 6 + 4$ are correct.</p>	
<p>Knowledge and Understanding of the World</p>	<p><u>History</u> Big question: How has life changed for people within the last century?</p> <p>We will be exploring the different events that have happened in the last century? We will be learning about what a decade is and identifying different things from different decades? We will be learning about how life was different for children in different decades.</p> <p><u>Vocabulary</u> decade, century, modern, recent, trend</p> <p><u>Computing</u> This week we will continue to explore the '2Paint A Picture' programme on Purple Mash. We will be looking at the work of William Morris, as well as exploring Surrealism and eCollage. We will be creating our own art work using inspiration from these styles.</p> <p><u>Vocabulary</u> repeating pattern, parallel, diagonal, rotated, symmetry, Surrealism, eCollage, stamps, clip-art.</p>	

Physical Development	Jenny will lead our Tuesday PE sessions and class teachers will lead sessions on Thursday. We will be learning Striking and Fielding skills, as well as exploring a variety of Athletics skills.
Any Other Information	<p>General reminders Please can you ensure that your child has the appropriate PE kit in school. Our PE days are Tuesday and Thursday.
