

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

- During our Jigsaw lessons, we will be learning how to celebrate differences.
- We will consider what we are good at and what makes us special, as well as learning about different types of homes and families.
- We will learn how to work as part of a team. We will play turn taking games, as well as working collaboratively in the construction area.

Physical Development:

- We will continue to develop our fine motor skills, for example using tweezers, weaving materials and playdough.
- We will introduce cursive letters, using our Letter Join scheme.
- We will take part in floor-based gymnastics sessions during PE.
- We will learn how to travel in different ways, as well as jump and balance safely.

Communication and Language:

- We will talk about our experiences using the past tense.
- Listen carefully to our talk partners and respond to their ideas.
- Join in with familiar stories, using enthusiasm.
- We will recall facts, using new vocabulary.
- We will make comparisons and share our knowledge.

Literacy:

- During phonics we will learn new sounds; *ff, ll, ss, j, v, w, x, y, z, zz, qu, ch, sh, th, ng, nk*
- We will also learn tricky words; *put, pull, full, as, and, has, his, her, go, no, to into, she, push, he, of, we, me, be*
- We will label our pictures, using initial sounds or words spelt in a phonetical way
- At the end of the term, we will write lists and letters to Santa!

Autumn 2- We Are Explorers



Maths:

- We will learn to make comparisons between amounts (more/ fewer/ equal to).
- We will use positional language (above, below ect).
- We will practise counting accurately.
- We will explore repeating and accumulating patterns.
- We will explore the composition of 3, 4 and 5, using the language 'whole' and 'part'.
- We will discuss the features of 2D shapes.

Understanding The World:

- We will create journey sticks.
- We will consider how maps can be used.
- We will explore our immediate environment and create maps of our classroom and school.
- We will learn about Diwali and how this is celebrated.
- We will investigate different types of bears and make comparisons about their habitats, diets and skills.
- We will learn about hibernation.

Expressive Art and Design:

- We use a range of media to represent our experiences, for example firework pictures.
- We will use salt dough to create Diva Lamps.
- We will learn how to create Rangoli patterns.
- We will use materials and construction resources to create a bear den.
- We will learn our Nativity songs and perform this to an audience.

- Read three times a week (phonics book) and share a choosing book.
