

Area of learning	What we will be learning	
Communication, Language and Literacy	<p>We will be learning the importance of questions and question marks.</p> <p>We are learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Identify question words.</i> • <i>Recognise that questions help us find out more information.</i> • <i>Identify question marks in sentences.</i> • <i>Use questions in our everyday vocabulary.</i> • <i>Create a design, make and evaluate sheet for our DT learning.</i> <p>You can help me at home by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Asking me questions during our imaginative play and games. - Encouraging me to ask questions to find out more about my favourite topics. 	<p>Phonics focus: Learning our new golden sounds. o/i/a/e</p> <p>New tricky words: Mr, Mrs, Ms, ask.</p> <p>You can help me at home by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Practising our new sound - Finding our new sounds in books and on signs.
Handwriting:	<p>We are starting to use lead ins in all our writing and are focusing on:</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div>	
Mathematical Development	<p>We will be building on our understanding of the composition of numbers 0 – 10.</p> <p>We will be learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Count from 0 -10</i> • <i>Use the five and a bit method for numbers six, seven, eight, nine.</i> • <i>Use a number line to count forward.</i> • <i>Identify numbers by words and numerals.</i> <p>You can ask me:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - To build a number line at home. - Create towers of numbers 0 –10. 	
Maths Fluency	<p>This week's activities will provide the children with an opportunity to consolidate their understanding of doubles, and to practise making and recalling doubles up to double 5. The children will first be asked to identify whether 2 sets of objects have an equal number or not.</p>	
Computing	<p>We will be learning to log into our Purple Mash accounts and exploring the website. We will be creating and saving a document on Purple Mash.</p> <p>We will also refamiliarise ourselves with the school laptops and trackpads.</p>	
JIGSAW	<p>This term we will be learning the importance of Celebrating our Differences.</p> <p>We will be focusing on how we are all unique and special.</p>	

Physical Development	<p>Jenny will lead Friday PE sessions and class teachers will lead sessions on Monday. We will be learning playground games and practising ball skills this term.</p> <p>We are learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>Improve hand eye co ordination</i>• <i>Develop underarm swing</i>• <i>Control a ball</i>• <i>Participate in group games</i> <p>Our PE days are Monday and Friday. Thank you to everyone who has already sent a PE kit in. On Mondays we will be learning playground games we can play with our friends at playtime. Please ask the children what games we have learned. On Fridays we are focusing on ball skills including throwing and catching.</p>
