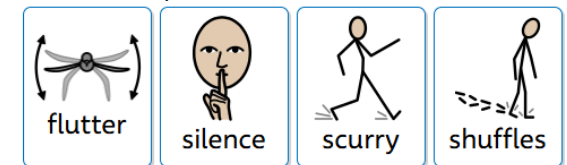

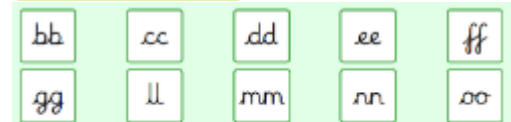
This term, we will write about real events, use commas in lists, join ideas using words like *when* and *because*, and build longer words using suffixes, while exploring patterns in stories and poems.

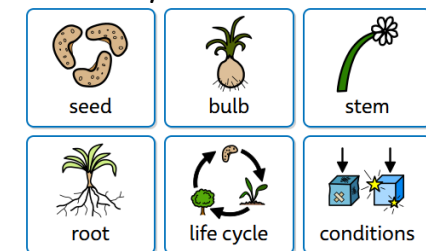
