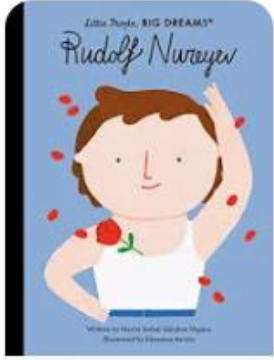
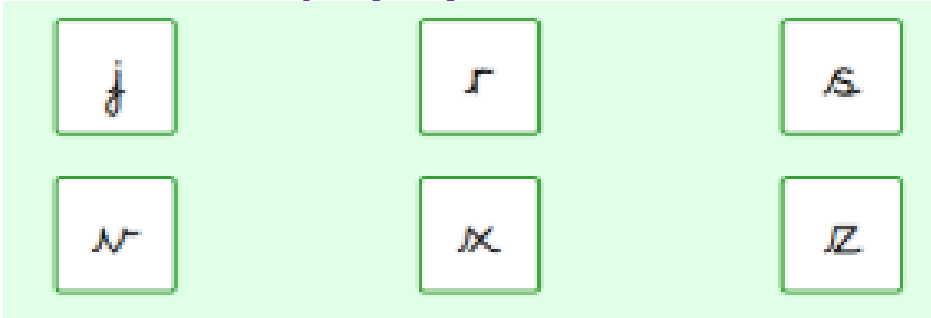
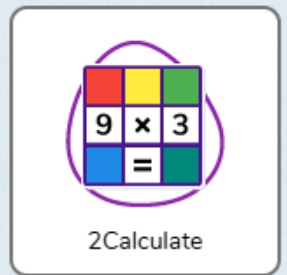

Area of learning	What we will be learning		
Communication, Language and Literacy	 <i>Little Thinker, BIG DREAMS!</i> <i>Rudolf Nureyev</i>	This week we will be starting to think about our new topic – Going for Gold! <u>This week we are learning:</u> • Can I write facts I have learned about Rudolf Nureyev? • What makes a biography different from other books? • Can I find out information for a biography? • Can I talk about someone who inspires me? <u>Could you practise:</u> – Think about who inspires you. Can you find out some facts about their life? Why do they inspire you? What are they famous for? – Talk about what features non-fiction books have and read some of these at home.	<u>Phonics and spelling focus:</u> Why do some longer words have the spelling ti for /sh/? GPCS - sh/ sh ti ch ssi ci si s 
	<u>Handwriting:</u> This term we will look at joining tricky letters:  Could you please practise these at home.		
Mathematical Development	We will be learning telling the time to an hour, half an hour and quarter of an hour. This week we will be: • Learning what quarter to looks like. • Using all we have learnt to tell the time. • Drawing times on a clock <u>Could you practise:</u> - Write different times ending in :45 on pieces of paper (e.g. quarter to 2, quarter to 6, quarter to 9). Ask your child to say the time aloud and explain which hour comes next. - Draw several blank clocks and write a time underneath each one. Ask your child to draw the hour and minute hands correctly.		

Computing	We will be using 2calculate on purple mash to investigate adding data to spreadsheets. • To explore how spreadsheets can complete calculations automatically. • To explore the range of tools available in 2Calculate and understand how they can change the way data is used. 
Jigsaw	Our Jigsaw learning continues to focus on the topic of 'Changing me' This week's learning: Can I talk about the process of getting older?
