Mathematical Development	We will be learning understanding data. This week we will be: • Collecting data and recording it in a tally chart. • Making pictograms • Making block diagrams <u>At home have a go at:</u> - Ask 5–10 family members or friends, "What is your favourite fruit?" Collect the answers and record them in a tally chart. Use the information to make a pictogram. OR - Sort your toys into groups (e.g. cars, teddies, dolls, building blocks). Count how many are in each group. Record the information in a table. Draw a block diagram using the data. 2Graph  Create line, bar, block and pie charts. Compare multiple graphs and multiple datasets to analyse your data. You can use purple mash to make your graphs!
