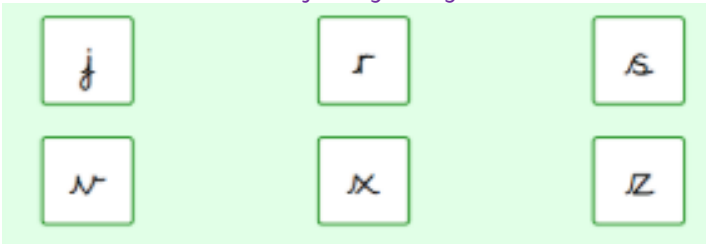

Area of learning	What we will be learning
Communication, Language and Literacy	This week we will be starting to look at a new book.  Phonics and spelling When do I swap, or drop letters before a suffix? (-er, -est, -ed, -ing, -y)  focus: double adding <u>This week we are learning:</u> • Can I write questions and statements about a mystery? • Can I make predictions? • Can I ask and answer questions in role?
	<u>Handwriting:</u> This term we will look at joining tricky letters:  Could you please practise these at home.
Mathematical Development	We will be learning about statistics This week we will be: • Interpreting pictograms, bar charts. • Looking at position and direction. <u>At home have a go at:</u> Treasure Hunt Survey! Ask your child to go on a mini treasure hunt around the house and collect data. Find and count objects from around the home, such as: • Toys • Books • Shoes • Cushions • Teddies Record how many of each item you find and then create a Pictogram or Bar Chart
Science	In science we are learning about Animals including Humans. This week we are learning: • How can food help us stay healthy? • Why are exercise and hygiene important?
Jigsaw	Our Jigsaw learning continues to focus on the topic of 'Changing me' This week's learning: • To recognise the physical differences between boys and girls, use the correct names for parts of the body and appreciate that some parts of my body are private • Can tell you what I like/don't like about being a boy/girl
