Personal, Social, and Emotional Development.	<p>We are learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - developing our understanding of how to contribute to the life of the classroom and the expectations and behaviour of year 1. - discussing our feelings and how these can affect our peers. - making a class charter. - creating helping hands to remind us of the adults who keep us safe. 	
Physical Development	<p>We are learning to: Work as a team and play different games in small groups.</p>	
Art	<p>We are learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Mix shades of the same colour. - Think about how to improve our creations. - Talk to your child about primary and secondary colours or practice colour mixing at home. 	
Science	<p>We are learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Observe signs of autumn 	
Geography	<p>We are learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Think about houses around Hassocks. - Begin to describe our own home and compare it to other houses.
