

Physical Development	<p>We are learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Work as a team and play different games in small groups. - Practice our hand eye coordination through throwing and catching. 	
Art	<p>We are learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Create our own Henri Rosseau masterpieces! 	
Science	<p>We are learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Observe signs of Autumn by going on a walk around the school. 	
Geography	<p>We are learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Looking at old homes.
