

Mathematical Development	<p>We are learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Find and recall the number bonds to 10 - To work systematically - To compare number bonds using more/less and equal to. 	
Personal, Social, and Emotional Development.	<p>We are learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Reflect on our first half term in Year 1. - Continue to learn about Black History month. 	
Physical Development	<p>We are learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Work as a team and play different games in small groups. - Practice our hand eye coordination through throwing and catching. 	
Science	<p>We are learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Name common trees around the school grounds. - Label parts of a tree. - Name deciduous and evergreen trees. 	
Geography	<p>We are learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Think about our local area and what improvements we can make. - We will be town planners, draw, and write about our ideas for improvements.
